Visiting Nurse provides compassionate care to alleviate suffering and ensure quality of life for those affected by serious illness. An Indiana-based non-profit agency, Visiting Nurse is staffed with experienced and skilled hospice and palliative care team members. We provide care in the patient's home, in assisted living facilities, in nursing homes or in Hospice Home.

In March 2020, Visiting Nurse acquired Family LifeCare, a nonprofit provider of home health care, palliative, hospice and grief support services. Visiting Nurse and Family LifeCare have similar missions, philosophies of care and staff dedicated to serving patients and families in need. Patients, families and healthcare partners previously served by both organizations will be reassured to know that the same level of quality care will continue to be delivered by staff members that reside in their communities.

Our Services

Visiting Nurse provides home health, palliative, hospice and grief support services – distinct approaches that can help people facing serious illnesses and their families.

Home Health CHRONIC DISEASE MANAGEMENT

Our skilled nurses and home health aides will ensure patient safety and comfort as you recover from illness or injury. Our Home Health Care program has a focus on supporting patients who have a skilled need and a serious illness diagnosis such as End Stage COPD, CHF, Renal Disease and Advanced Cancer. We will design an individual plan of care, coordinating with your physician to ensure you have the highest quality of life. Our goal is to help you stay out of the hospital and in your own home. Visiting Nurse provides skilled home health care in your residential home, assisted and independent living communities. We work collaboratively with facility staff to ensure that you are receiving coordinated care.

Palliative Care

Palliative medicine is patient- and familycentered care, provided by physicians and nurse practitioners, for those facing serious and chronic illnesses. Palliative medicine involves addressing physical, emotional and social needs to help patient autonomy, access to information and choice. Palliative medicine also focuses on providing relief from symptoms and stresses of a serious illness. The goal is to improve quality of life for patients and families. Patients can still be seeking curative treatment. Visiting Nurse provides palliative medicine consultations at locations in Fort Wayne, Berne and Marion, IN.

O Hospice Care

Hospice is a special type of care for people facing a life-limiting illness or injury and their families and caregivers. Hospice helps patients as well as their families live as fully as possible. We treat the patient, not the disease, and the focus is on caring, not curing. With hospice care, a team of healthcare experts and trained volunteers will address symptom control, pain management and emotional and spiritual support designed for the patient's needs and wishes. Hospice is not "giving up," it's about giving you the best quality of life. The sooner you begin hospice care, the sooner Visiting Nurse can provide care for you and your family. Hospice care is available for individuals who have received a serious diagnosis and have a life expectancy of 6 months or less.



Hospice Home

Visiting Nurse's Hospice Home provides high-quality, patient-focused medical care to those needing more intensive treatment than can be managed at home. Hospice Home is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and visitors are welcome at any time, day or night. • Staffed around the clock with dedicated hospice-certified caregivers

- Respite care available
- Hospice phγsicians who visit patients and meet with families to manage patient care
